ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1727

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Wheat) Exemption Order, 1937.

2. All wheat imported into the Colony during the period commencing on the 21st day of January, 1937, and ending on the 30th day of April, 1937, both days inclusive, shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.
