THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1750

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) (Amendment) Order, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Order, 1934, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage and Postal Charges) Orders, 1934 and 1937.

2. The following item—

"EXPRESS DELIVERY FEE.

For each postal packet (including parcels) .. .. 5"

shall be substituted for the item—

"EXPRESS DELIVERY FEE (United Kingdom and Egypt only).

For each postal packet .. .. 5"

in that part of the Schedule to the Principal Order headed "FOR ABROAD".

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 15th day of July, 1937.
