§ THE CUSTOMS LAW, 1936.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1752

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 52 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Flax Yarn) Exemption Order, 1937.

2. Flax yarn imported into the Colony from any part of the British Empire, within the period of one year from the date hereof, by any owner of a factory for the weaving of cloth therefrom, shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.
