REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 33 (d).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 33 (d) of the Antiquities Law, 1935, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Museums and Ancient Monuments (Admission Fees) Amendment Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Museums and Ancient Monuments (Admission Fees) Regulations, 1936, and (No. 1) 1936, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Museums and Ancient Monuments (Admission Fees) Regulations, 1936 to 1937.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the Ancient Monuments, Museums and Fees set out in the Schedule hereto.
