In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Law, 1936, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Cotton Seed) Order, 1937.

2. From and after the date hereof the exportation of cotton seed is prohibited save under the authority of a licence granted by the Director of Agriculture and subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in such licence.
