§ THE GOVERNMENT WATERWORKS LAW, 1928.  
REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 34.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 34 of the Government Waterworks Law, 1928, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Irrigation Charges (Amendment) Regulations, 1937, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Irrigation Charges Regulations, 1931 and 1937.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "Wheat or vetches" and the substitution therefor of the words "Wheat, vetches or flax".

**The Customs Law, 1936.**

NOTIFICATION.
