THE CONTAGIOUS DISEASES (ANIMALS) LAW, 1880.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Contagious Diseases (Animals) Law, 1880, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Hides and Skins Regulations (Amendment) Order, 1938, and shall be read as one with the Importation of Hides and Skins Regulations Order, 1924, (hereinafter Gazette: called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Importation of Hides and Skins Regulations Orders, 1924 and 1938.
