## SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 182. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1938.

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1875

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

W. D. BATTERSHILL,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited Exports (Essential Goods) Order, 1939.
  - 2. The exportation from the Colony—
  - (a) of the goods specified in the First Schedule hereto to all destinations;
  - (b) of the goods specified in the Second Schedule hereto to all destinations other than British ports and ports in Palestine and Egypt,

is prohibited save under a licence granted by the Governor and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such licence.

## FIRST SCHEDULE.

Wheat.
Barley.

Edible oils.

Milk, dried or preserved. Cheese.

### SECOND SCHEDULE.

Horses. Mules. Donkeys. Harness and saddlery for military purposes. Cotton and waste. Cotton yarn. Cotton (manufactured). Flax and hemp, including waste of all kinds. Oats. 4 Hides and skins. Wool. Woollen and worsted yarns. Leather. Timber. Poultry (fowls, ducks, geese and turkeys). Gold ore. Chrome. Copper and pyrites.

Copper concentrates. Ferrous scrap. Non-ferrous scrap. Zinc ore and concentrates. Asbestos. Gypsum. Terra umbra. Manganese. Silk. Ground nuts. Linseed. Linseed oil. Oil seed. Oilseed cakes and meals. Cumin. Carobs. Fruit (all descriptions). Cigarettes. Wine. Spirits.
