ORDER

MADE UNDER

THE POLICE LAWS, 1878 TO 1934.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 23 of the Police Laws, 1878 to 1934, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the General Police Fund (Amendment) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the General Police Fund Order, 1936, (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order") and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the General Police Fund Orders, 1936 and 1940.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) By the deletion from clause 3 (c) thereof of the words " or Prison Service " (lines 5 and 6).
- (b) By the deletion from clause 5 thereof of the words " and Prison Service " (line 3) and of the words " or Prison Service " (lines 5 and 6 of the Proviso).
- (c) By the deletion from clause 6 thereof of the words " or Prison Service " (line 5).
