## THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Amendment (No. 12) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 11) 1940, (hereinafter called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Orders, 1940 to (No. 12) 1940.

2. Part 8 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 8.—RICE.

<i>Type of Rice.</i>	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
1. Egyptian rice 'Mamsuh'	4¼ piastres per oke.	34 shillings per bag of approximately 80 okes.
2. Rizzoni and all other types of rice .. .. .	4¾ piastres per oke.	36 shillings 4½ piastres per bag of approximately 80 okes.

In this Part of this Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of rice in quantities of not less than one bag of approximately 80 okes at any one time or at any single transaction."

3. Part 14 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 14.—EDIBLE COCONUT OIL.

<i>Type of Edible Coconut Oil.</i>	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
1. Ordinary edible coconut oil	15 piastres per oke.	12 piastres per oke.
2. Deodorized edible coconut oil in drums.	16 piastres per oke.	13 piastres per oke.
3. Deodorized edible coconut oil in new sealed tins of 14 okes.	16½ piastres per oke.	13 piastres and 30 paras per oke.
4. Deodorized edible coconut oil in new sealed tins of 2 okes or less.	22 piastres per oke.	19½ piastres per oke.

In this Part of this Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means—

(a) in respect of ordinary edible coconut oil and of deodorized edible coconut oil in drums, sale or purchase thereof in quantities in excess of 10 okes at any one time or at any single transaction, and

- (b) in respect of deodorized edible coconut oil in new sealed tins of 14 okes, sale or purchase thereof in quantities of not less than one tin of 14 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.
- (c) In respect of deodorized edible coconut oil in new sealed tins of 2 okes or less, sale or purchase thereof in quantities of not less than five tins of 2 okes or less at any one time or at any single transaction."

4. Part 21 of the First Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby repealed, and the following Part is substituted therefor:—

"PART 21.—SESAME.

	<i>Retail Price.</i>	<i>Wholesale Price.</i>
Sesame .. .. .	7 piastres and 10 paras per oke.	6 piastres and 25 paras per oke.

In this Part of this Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of sesame in quantities in excess of 20 okes at any one time or at any single transaction."
