THE SUMMER AFTERNOON RECESS LAW, 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1961

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Summer Afternoon Recess Law, 1938, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Summer Afternoon Recess (Amendment) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Summer Afternoon Recess Order, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Summer Afternoon Recess Order, 1940.

2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "between the hours of 12 noon to 2 p.m." (lines 6 and 7) and the substitution therefor of the words "between the hours of 1 p.m. and 3 p.m."

3. This Order shall come into operation as from the 24th day of July, 1940.
