THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACT, 1939.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

W. D. BATTERSHILL,

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Act, 1939, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Amendment Regulations, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1940.

2. The following regulation shall be inserted in the principal Regulations immediately after Regulation 5 thereof, as Regulation 5A:—

5A. The Governor may by order prohibit the importation into the Colony, except under licence, of any bank notes, currency notes, postal orders, securities or foreign currency."
