ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1963

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

W. D. BATTERSILL,

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Special Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1940.

2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the second column of the Schedule hereto, on letters, postcards, printed papers, commercial papers and samples intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected by air or surface route from the Colony to Palestine or Egypt and thence by air *via* Singapore to the country of destination.

SCHEDULE.

Country of Destination	Letters, Postcards, Printed Papers, Commercial Papers and Samples.
	For every 5 grammes or part thereof
To North America	<i>Piastres.</i> 24
To the United Kingdom (including Northern Ireland and Eire)	28
