I, the Governor in Council, on the recommendation of the Director of Antiquities, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 (1) of the Antiquities Law, 1935, do hereby direct the following additions, transfer and cancellation to be made in the First and Second Schedules in the Kyrenia District :—

No. 341. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1965

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (His Majesty's Forces Rates of Postage) Order, 1940.

2. Notwithstanding anything in any other Order contained no letter or postcard conveyed or delivered for conveyance by post by any member of His Majesty's Forces in the Colony and addressed to any part of the British Empire shall be charged with any rate of postage :

Provided that nothing in this Order contained shall apply to such letters which exceed 2 ozs. in weight or to such letters or postcards which are conveyed or delivered for conveyance by air mail involving the payment of air mail fees.
