NOTICE No. 11 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 4 and the substitution therefor of the following part:—

“PART 4.—LOCALLY-MADE MACARONI.

In this Part of the Schedule—

the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of locally-made macaroni in quantities of not less than one case of 18 to 20 okes in weight at any one time or at any single transaction.”
