THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAW, 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1924

MADE UNDER SECTION 29.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 29 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Law, 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and direct and it is hereby ordered and directed as follows:—

1. The Irrigation Division of Akacha shall be dissolved as from the 1st day of August, 1940.
2. Upon the dissolution of the said Irrigation Division the Mukhtars of Akacha shall take charge of and preserve the irrigation works until the 1st August, 1941, or until such date as a new Irrigation Division shall be formed, whichever is the sooner.
3. Any money in the hands of the Committee and the Treasurer of the said Irrigation Division shall be paid to the Commissioner of Nicosia to be utilized by him for such purpose of public utility in the village of Akacha as to him may seem fit.
