THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE)
REGULATIONS, 1939 TO (No. 1) 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Returns of Stocks of Barley) Order, 1940.

2. Within twenty days from the date of the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, every person (whether such person is a merchant, importer, dealer or otherwise) who has in his possession or under his control any quantity of barley exceeding in the aggregate one kilé shall complete and deliver to—

(a) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a town, the Commissioner of the District in which such town is situated, or

(b) in the case of a person residing in or carrying on business in a village, to the Mukhtar of the village in which he resides, a return, in the form set forth in the Schedule hereto, in respect of the total quantity of barley in his possession or under his control.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District, may authorize, by writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with, or for the purpose of checking the correctness or accuracy of any return made by such person under clause 2 of this Order.

4. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order, or

(b) makes, under clause 2 of this Order, a return which is false in any material particular,

shall be liable to the penalties prescribed in Regulation 63 (1) of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939 to (No. 1) 1939.
