THE WHEAT AND FLOUR (IMPORT DUTIES OF CUSTOMS VARIATION) LAW, 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1932

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Wheat and Flour (Import Duties of Customs Variation) Law, 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Wheat and Flour (Duties of Customs Variation) Order, 1940.

2. From and after the 14th March, 1940:—

(a) in lieu of the import duties of Customs specified in the fourth and fifth columns of the First Schedule to the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939, in respect of Item No. 46 there shall be levied and recovered on flour of wheat, rye or maize and crushed wheat and semolina imported into the Colony the import duties of Customs set out in the third and fourth columns of the First Schedule hereto respectively;

(b) in lieu of the import duties of Customs specified in the fourth and fifth columns of the First Schedule to the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1939, in respect of Item No. 108 there shall be levied and recovered on wheat imported into the Colony the import duties of Customs set out in the third and fourth columns of the Second Schedule hereto respectively.

3. The Wheat and Flour (Duties of Customs Variation) Orders, 1939, shall be revoked upon the coming into operation of this Order.
