THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1941.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2017

MADE UNDER SECTION 116 (a) (i).

Authority to the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lapithos to contract a loan.

W. D. BATTERSHILL, Governor.

- I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 116 (\bar{a}) (i) of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1941, do hereby order as follows:—
- 1. That the Mayor, Deputy Mayor, Councillors and Townsmen of the Municipal Corporation of Lapithos (hereinafter referred to as "the Municipal Corporation"), shall be at liberty to borrow from Mr. Evriviades K. Siakidis, of Lapithos, (hereinafter called "the lender"), the sum of one hundred and thirty-five pounds (£135) at a rate of interest not exceeding six per centum (6%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say,—

(a) that the sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Municipal Corporation to the lender in ten equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest);

- (b) that the Municipal Corporation shall, in each year and until final repayment of the sum borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenues the annual sum payable as aforesaid in the year to which such estimates relate;
- (c) that the sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Municipal Corporation for the purpose of completion of the new Municipal Market.
- 2. That for the purpose of securing the repayment of the said sum of one hundred and thirty-five pounds the Municipal Corporation is hereby authorized to mortgage to the lender the rents for the storage of all classes of petroleum now payable or hereafter to become payable to the Municipal Corporation.
