No. 21.**THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940.****NOTICE No. 20 UNDER CLAUSE 13.**

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 18 and the substitution thereof of the following part:—

“PART 18.—MATCHES.

(1)	(2)	(3)
Brand of Matches	Retail Price	Wholesale Price
All brands	6½ piastres per packet of 10 boxes or 30 paras per box.	7 shillings per 100 boxes.

In this part of the Schedule—

the term ‘wholesale’ means sale or purchase of matches of not less than 100 boxes at any one time or at any single transaction.

Limitation.—No person selling matches by retail shall refuse to sell a packet of 10 boxes.”
