## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2025

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

- I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1941, do hereby order as follows:—
  - 1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Flour) Exemption Order, 1941.
- 2. From and after the 13th day of September, 1941, all flour of wheat, rye or maize imported into the Colony shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

NOTICE No. 44 UNDER CLAUSE 13.
