THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

C. C. WOOLLEY,  
Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, do hereby make the following regulations :—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Certification of Signatures (His Majesty's Forces) Regulations, 1942.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in any Law or public instrument, the signature of any member of His Majesty's Forces shall be deemed to be duly certified for all purposes if certified by the officer commanding his unit.

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have been made on the 1st day of January, 1942.
