This Order may be cited as the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) Amendment No. 1 Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) Orders, 1940 to 1941 (hereinafter called the "principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Sale of Tyres Control) Orders, 1940 to 1942.

2. Clause 5 of the principal Order is hereby revoked and the following clause is substituted therefor :—

"On and from the date of publication of this Order no person shall buy or sell or otherwise dispose of any tyres save under a permit issued under my hand."

No. 150. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Silk Cocoons Control) Order, 1942.

2.—(a) From and after the date of publication of this Order in the Gazette no person shall purchase or shall dry or treat in any manner any silk cocoons save under a special permit issued under my hand.

(b) Every special permit issued under the provisions of paragraph (a) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.

3. Every person shall permit such person as I or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

4. Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of this Order is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942.
