No. 170. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 4) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 4) 1942, I hereby make the following order :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation (Amendment) Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation Orders, 1940 and 1941, (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Order”), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Sale Prices of Scheduled Articles) Consolidation Orders, 1940 to 1942.

2. Clause 10 of the principal Order is hereby revoked.
