## THE BOATS REGULATION LAW, 1884.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by the Boats Regulation Law, 1884, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Direction, Orders and Regulations to be read as one with the Direction, Orders and Regulations, published in the *Gazette* of the 27th July, 1928, under Notification No. 478, the Direction, Orders and Regulations, published in the *Gazette* of the 27th December, 1929, under Notification No. 1043, and the Direction, Orders and Regulations published in the *Gazette* of the 27th March, 1933, under Notification No. 268 (hereinafter together called "the Principal Direction, Orders and Regulations") :—

**THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.**

**NOTICE No. 74 UNDER CLAUSE 13.**

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 17 and the substitution therefor of the following part :—

**"PART 17.—LOCAL CHEESE.**

In this part of the Schedule—

the term 'wholesale' means sale or purchase of local cheese in quantities in excess of 5 okes at any one time or at any single transaction.

*Modification* : Provided that where kaskavalli or tyri is sold in any town or village other than Nicosia there may be added to the maximum retail price one piastre per oke."

**No. 252. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 6) 1942.**

**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 6) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Drugs) Amendment Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Drugs) Order, 1940 (hereinafter called "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Drugs) Orders, 1940 and 1942.

2. The Third Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of items 33 and 37 therein appearing (relating to Tabs. quinine sulphate and Quinine).
