THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 8) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER REGULATION 22 (1) (c).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 22 (1) (c) of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Restriction of Movements of Aliens) Order, 1942.

2. Any alien who intends to be absent from his place of residence for more than six consecutive hours shall—

- (a) present himself to the Police Station nearest to his place of residence before departure;
- (b) present himself on arrival at the place of destination to the nearest Police Station and also to the same Police Station upon departure from such place;
- (c) present himself to the nearest Police Station on return to his place of residence:

Provided that nothing in this Order shall apply to any alien who possesses the nationality of any of the States named in the Schedule to this Order.

3. The Order published under Notification No. 242 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th June, 1940, is hereby revoked.
