THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 9) 1942.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Boots and Shoes) Order, 1942.

2. For the purposes of this Order—

“Leather Control Board” means the Board established under the Defence (Control of Local Hides and Local Leather) Orders, 1942.

3.—(1) From and after the 11th day of January, 1943, no person shall manufacture, make or repair or shall sell or expose for sale any boots, shoes or any other foot wear of any kind save under a permit issued by the Leather Control Board.

(2) Every permit issued under the provisions of sub-clause (1) hereof may contain such terms and conditions as may be specified therein.

4. Any person desiring to obtain a permit under this Order shall apply to the Leather Control Board, Nicosia, giving his full name and the address of his place of business and the number of persons employed in connection with such business.

5. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of, the provisions of the Defence (Licensing of Dealers of Certain Goods) Orders, 1942 to (No. 5) 1942 :

Provided that if any term or condition imposed under this Order is inconsistent with any term or condition imposed under the said Orders, the term or condition imposed by this Order shall prevail.

6. Any person who acts in contravention of any of the provisions of this Order or of any term, or condition contained in any permit issued to such person under this Order, is liable to the penalties prescribed in regulation 94 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 9) 1942.
