THE DEFENCE (CONTROL OF SALE PRICES OF SCHEDULED ARTICLES) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS, 1940 TO 1942.

NOTICE NO. 107 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 22 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“PART 22.—GAS OIL.

(1)	(2)
Price per Metric Ton.	Price for lesser quantity.
£18. 14s.	Proportionately to the price in column (1).

Modification:

Provided that where gas oil is sold in new sealed tins the price of each tin containing 4 gallons will be 7s. 7p.”

B.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 23 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“PART 23.—KEROSENE.

(1)	(2)
Price for every four gallons in bulk	Price for every four gallons in new sealed tins (<i>i.e.</i> with the tin).
54½ piastres.	67½ piastres.

Modification: The price for any lesser quantity of kerosene in bulk shall be :—

- (a) when sold by the oke in Sale's Centres a price not exceeding 5¾ piastres per oke on the basis of 11 okes net per four gallons ;
- (b) when sold by Mukhtars in villages other than Sale's Centres a price not exceeding 6½ piastres per oke on the basis of 11 okes net per four gallons.

The price for any lesser quantity of kerosene ex new sealed tins shall be :—

- (a) when sold by the oke in Sale's Centres a price not exceeding 6¾ piastres per oke on the basis of 11 okes net per four gallons ;
- (b) when sold by Mukhtars in villages other than Sale's Centres a price not exceeding 7¼ piastres per oke on the basis of 11 okes net per four gallons.”

C.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 24 and the substitution therefor of the following :—

“PART 24.—PETROL.

(1)	(2)
Price for every 4 gallons in bulk ex pump, sleeve cap tin or 2-gallon can.	Price for every 4 gallons in new sealed tin (<i>i.e.</i> with tin).
13 shillings and 3½ piastres	14 shillings and 7½ piastres.”
