No. 309. THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS LAW, 1935.

DECLARATION OF REFORMATORY UNDER SECTION 2.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935, do hereby declare the premises and lands set out in the Schedule hereto to be a Reformatory for the purposes of the said Law.

No. 310. THE PRISON DISCIPLINE LAW, 1879.

No. 311. THE JUVENILE OFFENDERS LAW, 1935.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 16.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Juvenile Offenders (Reformatory) Regulations, 1943.

2. In these regulations—

“Reformatory” means any place declared by the Governor to be a reformatory for the purposes of the Juvenile Offenders Law, 1935.

3. The Director of Education shall be in charge of the administration and control of the Reformatory.

4.—(1) The Reformatory shall be managed by a resident Director assisted by such other masters and mistresses as may be appointed by the Governor from time to time.

(2) The Director and any other person appointed under paragraph (1) of this regulation shall comply with any directions or instructions which they may receive from the Director of Education.

5.—(1) There shall be constituted a Board of Visitors to the Reformatory consisting of the Director of Education, the Director of Medical Services and the Commissioner of Nicosia.

(2) The Board of Visitors shall meet at such times and shall perform such duties with reference to the maintenance of good order and discipline in the Reformatory as they may think fit.

No. 312. THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1943.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF LIMASSOL.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 62 of the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1943, and of every other power hereunto enabling do hereby order that the Notification No. 286 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 12th August, 1943, (relating to the appointment of a Municipal Commissioner for the Municipal Corporation of Limassol) shall be amended by the deletion of the words "Oswald Raynor Arthur" which occur in the Schedule thereto and the substitution therefor of the words "Commissioner of Limassol".

No. 313. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

DELEGATION OF POWERS UNDER PARAGRAPH (5) OF REGULATION 66.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph (5) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, do hereby depute the Commissioner of each District to exercise and perform on my behalf the power to requisition any wreck within the meaning of the Wrecks Law, 1886, and the powers connected with such requisitioning conferred by paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4) of regulation 66 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, which I am empowered to exercise and perform thereunder.

No. 314. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 1) 1943.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as a Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 1) 1943, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Onion Movement and Control) (Revocation) Order, 1943.

2. The Defence (Onion Movement and Control) Order, 1943, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
