No. 382. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR.

Governor.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1942, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940 (Amendment) Regulations, 1943, and shall be read together with the Customs (Export Duty) Law, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Law").

(2) The interpretation Law, 1935, shall apply to these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law and for the purposes of the said Law these regulations shall be deemed to be Laws.

2. The proviso to sub-section (1) of section 5 of the principal Law is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "ten per centum" and the substitution therefor of the words "twenty per centum".

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have been made and to have come into operation on the 1st day of July, 1943.
