A PROCLAMATION.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

Whereas it is expedient that the village of Makheras, in the District of Nicosia, should be abolished:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power and authority enabling me in that behalf, I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the Decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby proclaim that the village of Makheras in the District of Nicosia shall, for all administrative purposes, be abolished as from the 1st day of July, 1944, and that the whole of the present area of the said village shall be transferred to Lazania village in the District of Nicosia and shall form one common area of the said village of Lazania as from the said date.

Given at Nicosia, this 31st day of May, 1944.

THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—

THE FOREST LAW, 1939.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2122

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

C. C. WOOLLEY,
Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Forest Law, 1939, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Main State Forest (Kormakiti Group) Order, 1944.
2. The areas of land and forests specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto, excluding the areas of land, and the immovable property other than land, specified in Part II of the said Schedule, are hereby declared to be Main State Forests for the purposes of the Forest Law, 1939.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1944, and as from that day the Order in Council No. 1990, dated the 28th December, 1940, which was published under Notification No. 476 in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazette* No. 2896 of the 30th December, 1940, shall be cancelled.

SCHEDULE.

PART I.

DESCRIPTION OF THE MAIN STATE FOREST.

1. The forests and the areas of land the boundaries whereof are shown on the Government Survey Plans hereinafter mentioned and thereon are delineated in green and recorded as the Kormakiti Forest Block No. 1, Kormakiti Forest Block No. 2, Kormakiti Forest Block No. 3,
