No. 259. THE HOTELS LAWS, 1935 TO 1943.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 12.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 12 of the Hotels Laws, 1935 to 1943, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Hotels (Amendment No. 3) Regulations, 1944 and shall be read as one with the Hotels Regulations, 1935 to (No. 2) 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Hotels Regulations, 1935 to (No. 3) 1944.

2. Regulation 1A of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the definition "inclusive terms" and the substitution therefor of the following definition:—

"'boarding terms' includes—

- (a) accommodation;
- (b) breakfast;
- (c) lunch;
- (d) dinner; and
- (e) bath."

3. Regulation 8 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "inclusive terms" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the words "boarding terms".

4. Regulation 8A of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after the word "hereto" (line 3) of the words "together with a copy of the definition of the expression "boarding terms".

5. Regulation 8B of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "inclusive terms" (lines 2 and 3) and the substitution therefor of the words "boarding terms".

6. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby repealed and the following Schedule substituted therefor :—

Provided that—

- (a) a Summer Resort Hotel shall be entitled to charge during the period 15th July to 30th September in every year up to 15% in excess of the above rate ;
- (b) in boarding terms accommodation with private bath room may be charged at 1*s.* per person extra.”

7. These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 20th July, 1944.

Provided that nothing in this regulation contained shall apply to accounts rendered or paid before that date.

**No. 260. THE DEFENCE (HEATERS CONTROL) ORDER, 1944.**

NOTIFICATION UNDER CLAUSE 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me under clause 3 (1) of the Defence (Heaters Control) Order, 1944, I hereby declare the 17th August, 1944, to be the date from and after which no person shall erect, use or work any wood burning heater of the following type without a licence from me, that is to say :—

Steam producing boilers whether stationary or mobile.
