No. 284. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1944.

ORDER UNDER REGULATION 55 (1) (b).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by regulation 55 (1) (b) of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1944, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order that the Defence (Use of Vehicles) Prohibition Order, 1944, be revoked.

2. This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th August, 1944.

No. 285. THE INTERPRETATION LAW, 1935.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 22 of the Interpretation Law, 1935, and of every other power hereunto enabling, do hereby order that the Schedule to the Delegation published under Notification No. 236 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 25th November, 1938, shall be amended as follows :—

(a) by the deletion therefrom of items 7 and 10 (in all the three columns thereof) and the substitution therefor of the following items, respectively :—

“ Laws	Powers and duties to be exercised or performed.	Office.
7. The Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944 ; section 26 (1).	7. To prescribe the names of the teachers to be appointed to each school.	7. The Director of Education.
10. The Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944 ; section 36 (1) (b).	10. To grant to a teacher such salary as he may think fit, where the second period of forty-two days' sick leave previously granted has expired.	10. The Director of Education.”

(b) by the addition thereto of the following item 10A :—

“ Laws	Powers and duties to be exercised or performed.	Office.
10A. The Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944 ; section 36 (3)	10A. To grant to a teacher study leave (including power to impose terms and conditions as provided by the said section).	10A. The Colonial Secretary.”
