SUBSIDIARY LEGISLATION.

No. 300. THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1943.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2133

MADE UNDER SECTION 9A.

Authority to the Village Health Commission of Pera to contract a loan.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9A of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1943, do hereby order as follows:—

The Village Health Commission of Pera (hereinafter referred to as "the Village Health Commission") shall be at liberty to borrow from the Village Commission of Pera (hereinafter referred to as "the lender"), the sum of forty pounds (£40) at a rate of interest not exceeding three per centum (3%) per annum subject to the following terms and conditions, that is to say:—

- (a) The sum borrowed shall be repayable by the Village Health Commission to the lender in three equal annual instalments (comprising sinking fund and interest).
- (b) The Village Health Commission shall, in each year and until the final repayment of the amount borrowed, insert in the annual estimates as a charge on the revenue the annual instalment payable in the year to which such estimates relate.
- (c) The sum borrowed shall be utilized by the Village Health Commission for the improvement of the drinking water supply of the village of Pera.

No. 301. THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Parcels Post (Rates of Postage) Orders, (to No. 2) 1944.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows :—

- (a) by the addition thereto in their alphabetical order of new entries relating to French Somaliland and Madagascar as set out in the 1st Schedule hereto ;
 (b) by the deletion therefrom of the entries relating to Argentine Republic and Brazil and the substitution therefor of the entries set out in the 2nd Schedule hereto.

No. 302. THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

No. 303. THE WAR LOAN LAW, 1944.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 17.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the War Loan Law, 1944, do hereby make the following regulations :—

- These regulations may be cited as the Second War Loan Regulations, 1944.
- In these regulations—
 “Board” means the Board appointed by the Governor under regulation 3 ;
 “drum” means the receptacle into which tickets are placed ;
 “vault” means the Government Treasury vault.
- (1) There shall be a Board consisting of the Treasurer as Chairman and six other members appointed by the Governor, who shall hold office for a period of two years from the date of their appointment.
 (2) The Board shall attend the drawing of lots and generally perform such other duties as may be necessary for the purposes of these regulations and three members thereof shall form a quorum.
