## No. 302. THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13 (2).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 13 (2) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, do hereby order that the Order relating to the Tree Planting Area of the village of Ayios Mamas, published in the *Gazette* of the 14th September, 1934, under Notification No. 966, shall be extended for a further period of five years from the date of the expiration thereof.

## No. 303. THE WAR LOAN LAW, 1944.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 17.

C. WOOLLEY,  
 Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 17 of the War Loan Law, 1944, do hereby make the following regulations :—

- These regulations may be cited as the Second War Loan Regulations, 1944.
- In these regulations—  
 “ Board ” means the Board appointed by the Governor under regulation 3 ;  
 “ drum ” means the receptacle into which tickets are placed ;  
 “ vault ” means the Government Treasury vault.
- (1) There shall be a Board consisting of the Treasurer as Chairman and six other members appointed by the Governor, who shall hold office for a period of two years from the date of their appointment.  
 (2) The Board shall attend the drawing of lots and generally perform such other duties as may be necessary for the purposes of these regulations and three members thereof shall form a quorum.
