I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 3 of the Minimum Wage Law, 1941, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wage (Shop and Office Employees) Order, 1944.

2. As from the 1st day of December, 1944 the minimum rates of wages to be paid generally in the Colony in respect of the categories of shop and office employees mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be the rates mentioned in the second column of such Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

Category.	Rate per month.
<i>Office and errand boys :</i>	
(1) Under 15	£3.
(2) Over 15 (first year)	£4. 10s.
(3) Over 15 (after first year)	£5. 10s.
<i>Clerks :</i>	
(1) First year	£6.
(2) After first year	£8.
<i>Shop Assistants :</i>	
(1) Under 16 (first year)	£3. 10s.
(2) Under 16 (after first year)	£4.
(3) Over 16 (first year)	£6.
(4) Over 16 (after first year)	£7.
