ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2148
MADE UNDER SECTION 79 (2).

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor in Council under section 79 (2) of the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1943, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby make the following rules:—

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Companies Rules, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Companies Rules, 1923 to 1931, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Companies Rules, 1923 to 1944.
2. The second form in the Fourth Schedule to the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1943, under the heading "Form as required by section 26 of the Law" shall be deleted and substituted by the form in the Schedule hereto.

No. 397. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1944.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2149

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

H. M. Foot,

Acting Governor.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1944, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Unfaced Mother-of-Pearl Blanks) Exemption Order, 1944.

2. From and after the 1st January, 1945, all unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks imported into the Colony by any person who satisfies the Comptroller of Customs that—

- (a) he is a *bona fide* button manufacturer; and
- (b) he imports such unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks solely for the purpose of manufacturing buttons therefrom for export from the Colony; and
- (c) such unfaced mother-of-pearl blanks are of British Empire origin,

shall be admitted free from all import duties:

Provided that before clearance from the Customs the importer shall sign a declaration in the form set out in the Schedule hereto.
