No. 149. THE COURTS OF JUSTICE LAWS, 1935 TO 1943.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 16 (5).

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 (5) of the Courts of Justice Laws, 1935 to 1943, do hereby order that Vedat Dervish Effendi, while acting as a Magistrate at Morphou, be empowered to hear and determine any action in which the amount in dispute or the value of the subject matter does not exceed fifty pounds.

No. 150. THE MOTOR CAR LAWS, 1921 TO 1936.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

C. C. WOOLLEY. Governor.

- I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Motor Car Laws, 1921 to 1936, do hereby make the following regulations:—
- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Motor Car (Amendment) Regulations, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Motor Car Regulations, Gazette: 1930 to 1942, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Motor Car Regulations, 1930 to 1945.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended as follows:—

(a) by the deletion from the proviso to paragraph (12) of regulation 20 of the words ", upon the recommendation of the Director of Public Works,";

(b) by the deletion of the words "Director of Public Works" whenever they occur and the substitution therefor of the word "Registrar".
