THE IRRIGATION DIVISIONS (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1938 AND 1944.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Lagoudhera, in the District of Nicosia, are published in the *Gazette*.

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF LAGOUDHERA, Rules.

1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Lagoudhera (Amendment No. 1) Rules, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Irrigation Division of Lagoudhera Rules, 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules") and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Irrigation Division of Lagoudhera Rules, 1945 and (No. 1) 1945.

2. Rule 5 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "ten shillings" and the substitution therefor of the words "sixty shillings".
