ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE

REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Slaughter of 23.104), p.3/3 Cattle) Order, 1946.

REPL. S.C. May, "cattle" means a bull, cow, heifer or ox.

3. Save under a permit in writing from the Chief Veterinary Officer or any person authorized by him in writing in that behalf or from a member of the Police Force, no person shall—

(a) slaughter or permit or suffer to be slaughtered, any cattle;

(b) assist in the slaughtering or dressing of the carcass of any cattle;

(c) sell or expose for sale the carcass of any cattle, unless such cattle has or had four or more fully grown permanent incisor teeth.

Every permit issued under clause 3 of this Order shall not be valid for more than twenty-four hours and shall on request be produced by the person slaughtering the cattle or selling or exposing for sale the carcass of the cattle to any Government Official or to any person authorized under clause 5 of this Order.

5. Every person shall permit such person as I, or the Commissioner of the District may authorize in writing in that behalf, to enter upon and inspect his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

6. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order;

(b) makes any false statement in any application for a permit under this Order;

(c) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.

7. The Defence (Control of Slaughter of Cattle) Orders, 1942 to 1944, are hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
