THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

Whereas at a meeting duly convened and held at the village of Lemithou, in the District of Limassol, on the 27th day of May, 1945, it was determined by the requisite majority of the voters present thereat that a certain area should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Lemithou.

And whereas at the said meeting the boundaries of the said area have been fixed and described :

And whereas the Mukhtar of the village of Lemithou has forwarded to the Commissioner of the District of Limassol a report, signed and sealed by him, containing a description with boundaries of the said area and stating that the said area fulfils the conditions in section 10 (4) of the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, prescribed :

And whereas the said Commissioner has transmitted the said report, together with his recommendations, to the Colonial Secretary for the consideration of the Governor :

And whereas the Governor considers it expedient, having regard to all the circumstances, that the area in the said report described should be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Lemithou.

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor, in exercise of the powers vested in him by the Tree Planting Village Areas Laws, 1930 to 1936, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

The area described in the Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be and shall be reserved as the Tree Planting Area of the village of Lemithou in the District of Limassol.

SCHEDULE.

The area lying within the following boundaries, that is to say :—

The boundary commences at the most northern point of plot No. 39 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXVII/33 on the District boundary Nicosia-Limassol, and proceeds north-eastwards along the said district boundary to the road from Kykko Monastery to the village of Lemithou at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 47 of the said plan ; thence south-eastwards and southwards along the said road to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 639 of the said plan,

locality "Potaminoudhi"; thence south-eastwards and southwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 639, 626, 454, 456, 453, 450, 449 of the said plan, plots Nos. 211, 213, 212, 215, of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXVII/41 locality "Yiannaki" to the footpath at the north-western corner of plot No. 300; thence westwards and south-westwards along the said footpath to the most eastern point of plot No. 232 of the said plan; thence south-westwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 232, 170, locality "Limnia", plots Nos. 140, 141, 133, 132, 124, of the said plan to the most western point of the latter plot No. 124 locality "Dhasino"; thence southwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of plot No. 122 of the said plan; thence westwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 122, 80, 79, and 73 of the said plan to the road from the village of Tris Elies to Kykko Monastery at the south-western corner of plot No. 73 of the said plan; thence north-westwards along the said road to the footpath at the most southern point of plot No. 71 of the said plan; thence north-eastwards along the said footpath to the south-eastern corner of plot No. 191 of the said plan locality "Kremmos"; thence northwards along the eastern and northern boundaries of plot No. 191 to the road from the village of Tris Elies to Kykkō Monastery at the most western point of plot No. 194 of the said plan; thence north-eastwards along the said road to the footpath at the north-western corner of plot No. 561 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXVII/33; thence north-eastwards along the said footpath to its end at the north-western corner of plot No. 174 of the said plan; thence northwards along the boundaries of and including plots Nos. 170, 169, 168, 41, and 38 of the said plan to the point of commencement; all which said area is 671 donums or thereabouts, as shown edged in red on the plan filed in D.L.R.S. M.P. No. 186/41.

THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT) LAW, 1933.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 8.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Agricultural Produce (Dried Figs) Export Regulations, 1946.

2. In these regulations—

"dried figs" means the dried fruit of the plant *Ficus carica*.

"Law" means the Agricultural Produce (Export) Law, 1933.

"inspector" means the produce inspector for the place of inspection at which the dried figs intended for export are submitted for examination.

3.—(1) Any person who intends to export any dried figs shall give notice to the inspector at the place of exportation at least three clear days before the proposed date of exportation stating the quantity of dried figs to be shipped.
