THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)  
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.

REV. 5-2-1949,

3-3-46 ORDER MADE BY A COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER DEFENCE  
REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of Defence Regulation 61 as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Supplies and Services (Control of Perishable Goods) Order, 1946.

2. In this Order—

“Perishable Goods” means the articles of food as set out from time to time in the First Schedule to this Order;

“Area” means the area within the limits of a radius of five miles from the municipal offices of each one of the towns or villages as set out from time to time in the Second Schedule to this Order.

3. The maximum prices at which any perishable goods may be sold in any area shall be fixed by me:

Provided that I may from time to time appoint a committee, consisting of a chairman and such number of members as I may think fit, for the purpose of fixing the maximum prices at which any perishable goods may be sold in any area by producers of such goods.

4. A copy of the list of prices fixed under clause 3 of this Order, in Greek and Turkish, shall be posted up in a conspicuous place in the municipal market of the area in respect of which such prices were fixed and in a conspicuous place in every village situated within such area.

5. A certificate under my hand regarding—

(a) the maximum prices, as fixed by me, at which any perishable goods can be sold within any area; and

(b) the posting of any list of prices in any area, shall be admitted in evidence as conclusive proof of the facts set out therein.

6.—(1) No person shall, within any area—

(a) have in his possession or under his control for any purpose other than for ordinary domestic purposes;

(b) deal with, sell or expose for sale, any perishable goods without a licence issued under my hand or under the hand of any person authorised by me in that behalf.

(2) Any person desiring to obtain a licence under sub-clause (1) of this clause shall apply in writing to me setting forth his full name and address and the premises or place at which the perishable goods are placed or stored or at which he proposes to deal with, sell or expose for sale such goods.

(3) A licence issued under this clause shall be exhibited by the holder in a conspicuous place in such premises or place as may be specified in the licence.

7.—(1) Unless cancelled as in clause 14 (2) hereof provided, every licence issued under clause 6 shall be valid for three months from the date of issue but may be renewed at my discretion.

(2) The renewal of any such licence may be effected by a note to that effect made thereon subject to such terms, limitations and conditions as may be specified in such renewal.

(3) Any holder of a licence to whom renewal of such licence has been refused shall dispose of any perishable goods as may be in his possession within a period of three days from the date of the expiration of his licence.

8. I may, from time to time, by publication in the *Gazette* prohibit the transport or removal of any perishable goods from any place in the Colony specified therein and thereupon no person shall transport or remove or cause or allow to be transported or removed such perishable goods from such place, save under a licence issued under my hand or under the hand of any person authorised by me in that behalf.

9. A licence under this Order may be issued or refused at my discretion and may contain such terms, limitations and conditions as may be specified therein.

10. Any person aggrieved by my decision under clause 7, 9, or 14 (2) of this Order may within three days from the date of the notification of

such decision appeal to the Governor in Council, whose decision thereon shall be final and conclusive.

11. Every person shall permit such person as I may authorize in writing in that behalf to enter upon his premises for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Order have been or are being complied with.

12. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other provision requiring any person to obtain a licence in respect of any perishable goods under any Law, public instrument or any other Order.

13. The Schedules hereto may be amended by me by a notice published in the *Gazette* and upon such publication such amendment shall form part of this Order for all purposes.

14.—(1) Any person who—

- (a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any of the provisions of this Order ;
- (b) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any term, limitation or condition in any licence, issued or renewed under this Order ;
- (c) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order ;

is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations as set out in the First Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946.

(2) The licence of any person convicted under the provisions of this Order may be cancelled by me.

15. Nothing in this Order contained shall apply—

- (a) to any perishable goods in my possession or under my control ;
- (b) to any dealing or sale of any perishable goods by me or on my behalf or in connection with any scheme for perishable goods operated by me ;
- (c) to any transport or removal of perishable goods by me or on my behalf.
