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No. 211. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1945.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2197

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1945, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import Duty (Special Boiling Point Benzine) Exemption Order, 1946.

2. Special Boiling Point Benzine imported into the Colony by any *bona fide* industrialist and proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs to be solely for use in his industry shall be admitted free from all import duties.
