THE CYPRUS VOLUNTEER FORCE LAWS, 1940 TO 1944.

PROCLAMATION MADE UNDER SECTION 22.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, Charles Campbell Woolley, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, upon whom has been conferred the decoration of the Military Cross, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 22 of the Cyprus Volunteer Force Laws, 1940 to 1944, do by this Proclamation disband all other ranks of the Force as from the 15th day of July, 1946.

Given under my hand and the Public Seal of the Colony at Troodos, this 8th day of July, 1946.

THE TREE PLANTING VILLAGE AREAS LAWS, 1930 TO 1936.
