No. 274. THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1945.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2204

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1945, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Import of Motor Lorries (Prohibition) Order, 1946.

2. The importation into the Colony of any motor lorry—

(a) the extreme width of which exceeds 7 feet; and

(b) the extreme length of which exceeds 21 feet; and

(c) the turning circle of which exceeds 60 feet,

is prohibited save with a licence under the hand of the Colonial Secretary and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in such licence.

3. The Import Motor Lorries (Prohibition) Order, 1937, is hereby revoked.
