ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2207

MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Forest Law, 1939, do hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Minor State Forests (Famagusta) (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Minor State Forests (Famagusta) Orders, 1943 to 1946, (hereinafter referred Gazettes: to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order Supplementary of the principal Order of the Principal Orde may together be cited as the Minor State Forests (Famagusta) Orders, 1943 to (No. 2) 1946.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the 20. 1.1944 addition thereto immediately after area No. 24 (relating to the village of

Syngrasi) of the following area:

25. Liopetri in the District of Famagusta:-

A portion of hali land of sheet XLII, plan No. 18 W at the locality 'Kokkina Kaminia' demarcated by boundary stones numbered from 1 to 4A and thence along the cliff to boundary stone No. 15, 16 and boundary stone No. 1 comprising 62 donums and 1 evlek approximately and shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1318 delineated thereon in green and marked 'B'.'

No. 327. THE FOREST REGULATIONS, 1940 TO 1944.

NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 6.

It is hereby notified for general information that, in virtue of the authority vested in him by regulation 6 of the Forest Regulations, 1940 to 1944, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that the areas set out in the Schedule hereto forming part of the areas of land and forests specified in Part I of the Schedule to the Minor State Forest (Xylophagou Group) Order, 1941, shall be reserved as Village Fuel Areas for the villages referred to in the Schedule hereto, respectively.

SCHEDULE.

1. Liopetri in the District of Famagusta:-

The whole of Potamos Block Forests, plot No. 246 of Sheet XLII. Plan No. 18 W., demarcated by boundary stones numbered No. 15 and along the cliff to boundary stone No. 4 A. and then to boundary stone 5 to 15 inclusive comprising 89 donums and 2 evleks approximately and shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1318 delineated thereon in green and marked "A".

2. Akhna in the District of Famagusta:-

(i) The whole of Akhna Block No. III, Sheet XXXII, Plan No. 62 E. and W., demarcated by forest cairns numbered consecutively from 1 to 8 inclusive, comprising 156 donums approximately and shown on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1320 A. delineated thereon in green.

(ii) The whole of Akhna Block No. IV, Sheet XXXII, Plan No. 62 E. and sheet XLI, Plan No. 6 E. demarcated by forest cairns numbered consecutively from 1 to 5 inclusive, comprising 62 donums and 3 evleks approximately and shown on the Government Survey Plan

Serial No. 1320 B., delineated thereon in green.

(iii) The whole of Akhna Block No. V, Sheet XLI, Plan No. 6 E., and Sheet XLI, Plan No. 7 W., demarcated by forest cairns numbered consecutively from 1 to 5 inclusive, comprising 45 donums and 2 evleks approximately and shown on the Governmet Survey Plan Serial No. 1320 C., delineated thereon in green.
