I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1945, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Import Duty (Charitable Institutions for Illegal Immigrants) Exemption Order, 1946.

2. All goods imported by any charitable institution approved by the Governor, which are proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs to be solely for use in any place of detention of illegal immigrants detained under the Detention (Illegal Immigrants) Laws, 1946, shall be admitted into the Colony free from all import duties.

I, the Acting Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor in Council by section 65 (b) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1945, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Wharfage Dues (Charitable Institutions for Illegal Immigrants) Exemption Order, 1946.

2. All goods imported by any charitable institution approved by the Governor, which are proved to the satisfaction of the Comptroller of Customs to be solely for use in any place of detention of illegal immigrants detained under the Detention (Illegal Immigrants) Laws, 1946, shall be exempt from the payment of any wharfage dues for import.
