THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAWS, 1930 TO 1945.

BYE-LAWS MADE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION
 OF LIMASSOL.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Laws, 1930 to 1945, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Limassol hereby make the following bye-laws.

These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1946, and shall be read as one with the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1945, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Limassol) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1946.

2. The principal Bye-laws are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second Schedule and the substitution therefor of the following Schedule :—

A.—The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 25 and the substitution therefor of the following Part :—
