No. 62. The Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944.

In pursuance of the provisions of section 19 of the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Division of Orga in the District of Kyrenia, are published in the *Gazette*. (M.P. 972/45.)

IRRIGATION DIVISION OF ORGA.

Rules.

1. These Rules may be cited as the Irrigation Division of Orga Rules, 1946.
2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
 - “Commissioner” means the Commissioner of the District of Kyrenia;
 - “Committee” means the Committee of the Irrigation Division;
 - “Irrigation Division” means the Irrigation Division of Orga;
 - “Law” means the Irrigation Divisions (Villages) Laws, 1938 and 1944;
 - “list” means the list of the names and residence of the proprietors and of the lands and extent thereof which are to be benefited or are capable of being benefited by the works prepared under the provisions of section 15 of the Law as finally settled under the provisions of section 16 of the Law;
 - “works” means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Division.
3. The Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 14th October, 1945. Thereafter the election of the Committee shall
