

No. 113.**THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1944.****PRESCRIPTION OF GROUPS.****ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 6 (2).**

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 (2) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby order and prescribe as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Groups) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read as one with the Elementary Education (Prescription of Schools) Orders, 1944 to 1946 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Elementary Education (Prescription of Schools) Orders, 1944 to 1947.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion therein immediately after items 1 and 2 of the following items, respectively :—

" Religious communities.	Villages.	Towns.
1A. Greek-Orthodox	Omorphita.	Nicosia.
2A. Moslem	Kaimakli, Kuchuk (Omorphita) and Kaimakli, Beuyuk.	Nicosia."

3. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order and the Second Schedule thereto are hereby deleted.

4. The Third Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words " Kaimakli, Kuchuk (Omorphita)-Kaimakli, Beuyuk " in column 2 under the heading " Nicosia District " in respect of the Moslem religious community.

No. 114.**THE QUARANTINE LAW, 1932.****NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 4.**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 4 of the Quarantine Law, 1932, or otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to declare and hereby declares that the local areas in the first column of the Schedule hereto are infected local areas and that all passengers and goods therefrom shall, as from the date hereof, be subject to the measures prescribed by the Quarantine Regulations, 1932 to 1936, with respect to the dangerous infectious diseases in the second column of the Schedule hereto.

The Notification No. 101, published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 10th April, 1947, is hereby cancelled.
